

A very warm welcome to Jesmond Parish Church (JPC)

We are a very international church with students (both undergraduate and postgraduate), language students, visiting scholars and workers and families from all over the world – over 30 nationalities are represented. We meet together on Sundays and in smaller groups during the week.

On Sundays, we have services both in the morning and in the evening

We meet to hear God speak as the Bible is read and applied to our lives today and to encourage each other through praying and singing together. Everyone is welcome to come – you do not need to be a Christian. The morning services have children's groups.

If you are an undergraduate student you are welcome to join the famous Student Supper after the 6:30pm evening service – a hot filling meal and a chance to get to meet other students at the church.

Here are some of the groups and activities we run for internationals at Jesmond Parish Church during the week.

JPC Internationals every Friday, 6–8pm at 3 Osborne Road

The best way to belong to JPC is to join JPC Internationals where we meet together to hear a Bible talk and then move into small groups where we study the Bible and help each other to apply it to our lives and pray together. We have specific **groups for Mandarin speakers**. If you are new to Christianity, or would like to know more about what Christians believe, we have **beginners small groups** where you can learn more about Jesus and ask any questions you may have.

The Globe International Student Café every Monday, 7–9:30pm in the church halls



This is a fun place to make new friends and practise your English over a hot meal and fun activities. We also run day trips, weekends away and a weekly free English conversation class. Run by Christians in Newcastle.
